- ✓ Keep in touch with your child's teacher.
- ✓ Encourage your child to use appropriate language and tone.
- ✓ Practice positive phrases with your child, such as, "Thank you," "Excuse me," "Please," and "I'm sorry."
- ✓ Be a visible part of your child's school day. Attend PTA meetings and other school activities as your schedule allows.

What is Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports? (PBIS)

PBIS is a school-wide approach to discipline for creating safer and more effective schools. PBIS is a systems approach to enhancing the capacity of schools to educate all children by developing research-based, school-wide, and classroom discipline systems. The process focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for all students. With PBIS, instructional time is more effectively used for teaching and the overall school environment is calm and conducive to learning.

PBIS allows parents/guardians and teachers to have open communication about what is expected in all areas of the school. Our school's behavioral expectations centers on the ideas of responsibility, respect and safety. Even though the school district assumes a leading role in the PBIS program, its success is dependent upon the support of parents, local business and the surrounding community.
