- **(V)** Review the school expectations with your child.
- Ask your child about his/her day at school every day.
- Make sure your child is ready every day by getting lots of rest, eating healthy, and having proper clothes.
- 🚺 Ensure a good night's sleep.
- Provide a quiet time and space for your child to do homework nightly.
- Keep in touch with your child's teacher.
- Encourage your child to use appropriate language and tone.
- Practice positive phrases with your child, such as, "Thank you," "Excuse me," "Please," and "I'm sorry."
- Be a visible part of your child's school day. Attend PTA meetings and other school activities as your schedule allows.

# What is Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports? (PBIS)

PBIS is a school-wide approach to create a safer and more positive learning culture in our school. This research-based system establishes a process focused on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for all students. With PBIS, instructional time is more effectively used for teaching and the overall school environment is calm and conducive to learning.

PBIS allows parents/guardians and teachers to have open communication about what is expected in all areas of the school. Our school's behavioral expectations centers on the ideas of responsibility, respect, and safety. Even though the school district assumes a leading role in the PBIS program, its success is dependent upon the support of parents, local business, and the surrounding community.

A color coded continuum helps students monitor their behavioral choices.
