Athletics and Performing Arts COVID Mitigation Strategies

As winter sports begin, we have a [new set of screening, mask and quarantine protocols](#) in place based on the guidelines provided by the Washtenaw County Health Department. Our protocols involve testing MS/HS athletes and performers weekly and requiring students to wear masks EXCEPT when actively competing/practicing or performing. Close contact quarantine protocols vary based on vaccination status and activity. Athletes/performers identified as close contacts who are vaccinated will not need to quarantine if they are symptom free. Unvaccinated close contacts will be required to quarantine and will not be eligible to test to stay in school. Review the document linked above for more detail.
