WLES PROJECT PLAYGROUND:\$50 K FOR PLAY

We've Raised over \$23,500 for Project Playground!

With Project Playground: \$50k for Play, we will be fixing the elementary school playground from top to bottom this summer! This will cost near \$175,000. Thanks to the generosity of our community, \$110,000 of sinking fund dollars will be used towards the project. But because of rules from the state, sinking fund dollars CANNOT be used to purchase playground equipment. Thanks to a community build, instead of paying to have it installed, the entire build will be volunteer-driven, saving nearly \$9,000.

We know \$50k is a big number. But we also see it as 500 \$100 donations, or 1,000, \$50 donations, or a whole lot of \$1 and \$5 donations. No donation is too small! We know together, we can make a HUGE impact in the lives of students at WLES and children in the Whitmore Lake community for many years to come!

School Office Hours 7:15 AM - 4:15 PM

School Times: 5th and 6th Grades 7:50 AM - 2:35 PM Kindergarten – 4th Grades 8:50 AM – 3:35 PM

5th and 6th Grade students who eat breakfast at school may arrive and enter the building at 7:30 AM **5th and 6th Grade students** that walk to school should arrive no earlier than 7:40 AM and no later than 7:50 AM.

Kindergarten-4th **Grade students** who eat breakfast at school may arrive and enter the building at at 8:20 AM all other students can enter the building at 8:40 AM.



Kindergarten – 4th **Grade students** that walk to school should arrive no earlier than 8:40 AM and no later than 8:50 AM *See above for arrival and building entry if eating breakfast.*

Any student who arrives after 7:50 AM (5th/6th grade) or 8:50 AM (k-4th grade) MUST be walked in to the office, and signed in by a parent.
