As communicated in our district message, in anticipation of the negative side effects of the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine among our staff, we will have a pre-planned asynchronous remote learning day in lieu of a late notice cancellation. Assignments will be lighter than other asynchronous learning days for both in-person and virtual students. We hop this gives families and students more flexibility since we are giving you shorter notice than usual.

<u>In-person & Virtual K-6:</u> Asynchronous remote learning day at home.

#### **In-Person:**

- K-3 in-person will have paper assignments from Mrs. Roy-Borland and their specials teachers. Assignments should be turned into classroom teachers on Wednesday. No devices.
- 4-6 will have assignments in Google Classroom and should turn them in by the end of the day.
- No Zooming today.

#### Virtual:

- Teachers will put assignments in Seesaw (K-2) or Google Classroom (3-6).
- No Zooming today.
- Students are expected to complete the assignments and turn them in by the end of the day.
