Dear Whitmore Lake Elementary School Families,

All WLES staff returned to school today for a day of learning and preparation. All of you will have an opportunity to meet your child's teacher tonight or tomorrow. The real fun begins on Wednesday with a half-day of school!

There have been some common questions over the past few days. Here are the responses in case you are wondering about them too.

- <u>LUNCH</u>: Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria. We will limit the number of students in the cafeteria, leave space between students, and have assigned seats to keep cohorts together.
- <u>SPECIALS:</u> We are trying something new this year. Instead of rotating between specials every three days, students will have the same special for ~6 weeks then rotate to a new special. For example, one class might have art from the first day to early October, music from early October to mid-November, and gym from mid-November to mid-December. The rotations will repeat during the second semester.
- MASKS: Students, staff, and visitors will wear masks indoors at WLES while we are at substantial or high-risk levels.
- <u>SUPPLIES</u>: We have all the basics for every student. If you would like to donate an item to your child's classroom or the school, check out the WLPS Amazon wishlist: amzn.to/3BCEVCC
- <u>CROSSING GUARDS:</u> Crossing guards will be on duty from 7:35-7:50AM (5-6) and 8:35-8:50AM (K-4) Please plan your child's walking time accordingly.
- <u>DROP OFF & PICK UP:</u> It takes longer than everyone wants it to for the first few days. Once all staff, students, and families know the routine, it will be down to about 10 minutes start to finish!


ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Arrival and dismissal times are the busiest times of the day at WLES. Please help us keep it safe and efficient by remembering the following:

- Note the drop off times for arrival.
 - 5th & 6th grade: 7:40AM Kindergarten-4th grade: 8:40AM
 - Students will NOT be let in the building, off the bus, or out of vehicles before this time.
- Follow the directions on the Kiss and Go map below if you drop off or pick up your child.
- Stay in line unless directed by a staff member to pull around another vehicle.
- If your child is late for school, an adult must walk them to the school and wait for a staff member to sign them in.
- Please call in all dismissal changes to the office by 2:15PM for 5th 8 6th grade students and by 3:15PM for Kindergarten-4th grade students.
- At pick up, put a sign with your child's last name in large bold letters in your window so staff can easily read it from a distance. A sign will be provided to the youngest student in your family on the first day of school.
- Please be patient.

AM Drop Off

- Drop off opens at 7:40AM (5-6) and 8:40AM (K-4)
- Kids must stay in vehicles until 7:40/8:40AM
- Form 2 lanes of traffic (see map)
- At the last turn, merge into 1 lane, take turns (see map)
- Pull up as far as possible (see star on map) Staff members will move to you
- Adults stay in the vehicle
- Kids exit vehicle from passenger side
- Pull away with caution

PM Pick-Up

- Pick up opens at 2:35PM (5-6) and 3:35PM (K-4)
- Form 2 lanes of traffic (see map)
- At the last turn, merge into 1 lane, take turns (see map)
- Display a sign with your student's last name in the window
- Pull up as far as possible (see star on map) Your kids will walk to you
- Adults stay in the vehicle
- Kids enter vehicle from passenger side
- Pull away with caution
